Articles should contain a minimum of 350 words.

The subject of articles must be fishing on Illinois lakes, rivers, and ponds, with emphasis on locations and techniques used to catch fish rather than lake rules, accommodations, and other general information. We are looking for the how, where, and when of catching fish in our area. We are interested in details about fishing specific lakes or rivers in Illinois.

Articles should be original and current, written during the last six months. They should be submitted via email as either Microsoft Word (.doc) or plain text (.txt) documents. Photos and graphics are welcome, but not mandatory. Photos should be submitted via email as either .jpg or .gif attachments.

Submitters shall be entitled to a free display advertisement on ILFishing.com for three months for each published article. The ad will be 2 inches high X 3 inches wide (on an 800 X 600 resolution monitor) and can be for a personal or family business or a group chosen by the submitter. Placement and choice of web page for your ad will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. The ad may contain a link to your web site or your email address.

Advertisements can be designed by the submitter, but we will be glad to assist in layout and design free of charge. Logos may be submitted to include in ads, but they must be the appropriate size. You may be billed for original art work that we create.
